Antequera has some valuable leisure resources, such as the Town Library, a swimming-pool, a multiplex, sports clubs, and a wide choice of restaurants and bars.

The town is well known for its cultural offer. It has some important museums, such as Museum of the City of Antequera, Museum of Art, and the Museum of Andalusian Prehistory. In addition to that, monuments such as the Islamic fortress, the prehistoric dolmens, and the Royal Collegiate Church, together with numerous churches and convents, are open for visitors.

There is a wide range of outdoor activities to choose from near Antequera: Torcal de Antequera, Caminito del Rey, and the different sierras, which offer safe marked hikes.

In recent years, Antequera has been appointed European City of Sports due to the promotion of sporting activity in general.
