<b>Information about the town and/or neighborhood</b>	<p>Antequera is a medium-sized town with a population of 41000 inhabitants. It is located at the geographical heart of Andalucía. Drives to most relevant Andalusian cities take: Malaga: 40 minutes, Granada:1 hour, Córdoba: 1h15, Seville: 1h 30).</p> <p>In 2016 the town was appointed UNESCO World Heritage for its prehistoric dolmens, Lovers' Rock and natural reserve Torcal.</p> <p>The school is in the city centre, within walking distance to the bus station and high speed train station.</p> <p>Some useful websites:</p>

The town is well known for its cultural offer. It has some important museums, such as Museum of the City of Antequera, Museum of Art, and the Museum of Andalusian Prehistory. In addition to that, monuments such as the Islamic fortress, the prehistoric dolmens, and the Royal Collegiate Church, together with numerous churches and convents, are open for visitors. There is a wide range of outdoor activities to choose from near Antequera: Torcal de Antequera, Caminito del Rey, and the different sierras, which offer safe marked hikes. In recent years, Antequera has been appointed European City of Sports due to the promotion of sporting activity in general.</p>
<b>Getting to school</b>	<p>Public transport schedule:</p> <p><b>Bus:</b> <a href="#">ALSA</a> (aprox. 12€ return)</p> <p><b>Train:</b> <a href="#">RENFE</a> website. Please notice that there are two railway stations in Antequera: Antequera – Santa Ana, which lies 15 kilometres away from town. (High speed trains coming from Malaga) Antequera – Alta Velocidad: in town within walking distance from the school (Trains coming from Granada and Seville). Connection between both stations is not always possible (please check website)</p> <p><b>Carpooling:</b></p>



	It is a fact that we have staff driving from and to Malaga and Granada, but carpooling cannot be confirmed for sure until September.
